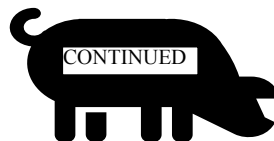
1. Animals exhibited in the open class at the Marion County Fair need not obtain health papers as in the past. The required paper has been replaced by the "Premise ID Number" issued by the IBAH. Please write your Premise ID number on the appropriate blank on the entry form.
****Entries cannot be accepted without the Premise ID Number.****

2. Entries will be taken the date of the show between 8 AM and Noon
An exhibitor may have any number of entries per class.

3. Entry Fee(s) are \$10.00 per animal and
Fees must be paid at the time of entry

GILT AND BARROW SHOW INFORMATION

Purebred Hogs ~ Purebred Gilt and Barrow Classes will be provided for the following breeds:

ALL Purebred Gilts must have registration papers available.

All other breeds must have Superintendent's approval.

GILT SHOW

1. Purebred Gilts will be shown by Date of Birth as follows:
 - a. December 2018
 - b. January 2019
 - c. February 2019
 - d. March 2019
2. Crossbred Gilts will be weighed and shown by weight only. Weight classes will be divided as evenly as practical.

BARROW SHOW

1. Barrows of any breed or cross may be exhibited.
2. Barrow classes will be shown by breed. If there are more than 10 animals in a class we will divide them by weight.
