Five nights of the fair will have an action packed event at the Grandstands. For \$5 per event and kids 5 and under are free, you are going to want to see them all. This year TQ Midget Racing will be returning along with a two night Demolition Derby. Motocross & quad racing and Outlaw Karts will also be happening for fairgoers' entertainment.

With more cars and a bigger arena, the 2 and a half hour show the two-night Demolition Derby is back and better than ever. There will be more classes this year including, Power Wheels, Mini-Vans, Full Size Gut n' Go, and more. Both nights will feature the special pretty car contest. With the improved track expect faster speeds than ever before. Each night of the derby for general admission is \$5 with children 5 and under being free. For \$10, audience members can get a pit pass/Power Wheels Driver pass. If you are interested in registering a car or driver, the cost is \$35. here will also be motocross & quad racing and Outlaw Karts to round out the Grandstands' events this year.
