QUEEN & PRINCESS PAGEANT

Pageant competition will be held at the Marion County Fairgrounds on Saturday, July 11th at 7p.m. Contestant must be a Marion County resident or have at least one parent who resides in Marion County.

Queen contestant must be at least 17 years of age on or before **June 1, 2020** and each Queen contestant cannot have reached their 21st birthday on or before **June 1, 2020**.

Princess contestant must be at least 14 years of age on or before **June 1, 2020** and each Princess contestant cannot have reached their 17th birthday on or before **June 1, 2020**.

- **Queen** - Selected from Queen candidates - will receive a \$1,000 scholarship
- **Queen First Runner-Up** - Selected from Queen candidates - will receive a \$100 scholarship
- **Queen Second Runner-Up** - Selected from Queen candidates - will receive a \$50 scholarship
- **Princess** - Selected from Princess candidates - will receive a \$200 scholarship
- **Princess First Runner-Up** – Selected from Princess candidates – will receive a \$50 scholarship
- **Miss Congeniality** - selected by candidates - will receive a \$50 scholarship
- **Miss People's Choice** -Selected by audience - will receive a \$50 scholarship

Each court member will receive Fair Bucks to use during the fair for their meals.
